# Deimler's Farmhouse

*Show stopping roofline adds charm to Pennsylvania countryside*

If the grape arbor and apple trees are any indication, it's going to be a very good year for Nancy and Gary Deimler. Says Deimler, "Ever since we've been married, we've talked about living on a farm. So when the Stone property was listed for auction, I thought I'd at least put in a bid. The auctioneer called everyone who had bid on the house, and we set about negotiating the deal. When it was over, my wife Nancy and I owned an 80-year-old, rundown farmhouse and a barn on 100 acres of land in Dauphin."

Deimler and his wife were up to the job of rebuilding the farm because for the last 25 years, they've run Harrisburg-based Gary Deimler & Sons Construction. With a bow to the late 19<sup>th</sup>-century origins of the farmhouse, the Deimlers were determined throughout the remodeling to maintain a Victorian-style exterior. To that end, Gary Deimler installed a patterned roof that, by all reports, "is a real stopper."

As he does for all of his new roofing customers, Deimler turned to Alsie Supply of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania and CertainTeed Corporation for roofing shingles. "Unless I have to match an existing roof," says Deimler, "I always use CertainTeed roofing products. They have a high quality product and excellent people who always follow up when I need them."

Before laying the roof, Deimler installed CertainTeed WinterGuard™ Waterproofing Shingle Underlayment. Deimler & Sons installed 45 squares of CertainTeed Carriage House Shingle™ on the farmhouse. The level of detail evident in its chamfered corners that look like hand-carved scalloped edges and two full-size base shingles that simulate the depth of natural slate made Carriage House their first pick. Also, the house itself is the focal point of the 70 acres the Deimlers have kept for themselves, so they wanted the Carriage House deep shadow lines and oversized 8-in. exposure that gives depth to the roof. With its virtual four layers of protection and limited lifetime warranty, this Carriage House roof is up to the task of protecting Gary and Nancy Deimler's dream house.

And to complete the Victorian styling, Deimler created flowers. The "petals" are individually cut Carriage House tabs in Georgian Brick; and the centers, Heirloom Silver. Ridges and hips are capped with a matching 8-in exposure, 2-layer accessory in Stonegate Gray.
